All children under 8 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

The registration and Enrollment fee is \$80 per person. (\$10 deposit plus \$70 upon arrival at camp.) The \$10 is transferable but not refundable. The total amount of the deposit for your campers should be paid with a check. To pay the balance due when you arrive at camp you should bring a check. All checks should be **made payable to PINE SPRINGS YOUTH ENCAMPMENT.**

The fee includes : room, meals, and insurance to and from camp and during the regular camp session. It does NOT include the cost of snacks, souvenirs, or supplies bought from the camp store.

**Trustee Rules For Camp: (Revised 10/2000)**  
These camp rules have been adopted by the Camp Trustees as a general guide for the conduct of those attending camp. Other Rules may be added by individual camp groups.

1. This is a Christian camp. The conduct of each camper should be in keeping with Christian camping.
2. Alcoholic beverages, firearms or gambling devices shall not be permitted on the camp grounds.
3. Modest dress should be practiced at all times. All clothing (whether dresses, pants shorts, cutoffs, etc.) shall be long enough that no skin will be touched with the fingertips while standing, with the arms held at the side.
4. Mixed swimming will not be permitted.
5. Smoking shall not be permitted on the camp grounds.
6. Each camper is expected to attend religious service and participate in the recreational and educational programs.
7. Campers are not to be left unsupervised in cabins at any time.
8. Counselors are responsible for the campers care of equipment and buildings.
9. Each camp group is expected to carefully clean the grounds and buildings before leaving the camp grounds.
10. Shaving cream fights and other building defacing activities are forbidden. Camp brochures should include this information.

Note: Rule number 3 has been re-written by the Trustees. The new wording constitutes a minimum standard which applies to all camps. Individual camps may add clothing requirements if they choose, but the standard set by the Trustees must be observed.

Camp #4 Night Services: Clothing considered appropriate for the Sunday Evening services at your church are to be worn during the evening services at camp.

### **Location of Camp**

From Henderson, Texas you will travel south on highway 259 for a distance of 12 miles, then west on FM 1798 for a distance of 3 miles. Pine Springs Youth Encampment is located four miles East of Laneville, Texas on FM 1798 in the beautiful pine covered hills of East Texas.
