All children under 8 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. You must provide one male adult sponsor per 8 boys and one female adult sponsor per 10 girls attending camp.

The registration and Enrollment fee is \$160 per person. (\$10 deposit plus \$150 upon arrival at camp.) The \$10 is transferable but not refundable. The total amount of the deposit for your campers should be paid with a check. To pay the balance due when you arrive at camp you should bring a check. All checks should be **made payable to Texas Camp #4**.

The fee includes : room, meals, and insurance to and from camp and during the regular camp session. It does NOT include the cost of snacks, souvenirs, or supplies bought from the camp store.

## What to Bring to Camp

## Trustee Rules For Camp: Rev. 2018

This is a Christian Camp. The conduct of each camper should be in keeping with Christian camping.

No personal pets are permitted during camps or retreats.

No smoking is permitted on camp property. Alcoholic beverages, firearms, or gambling are not permitted.

Modest dress should be practiced at all times. Swimming will be permitted only during scheduled periods when lifeguards are on duty.

Each camper is expected to attend religious services and participate in the recreational and educational programs.

Any building defacing activities are forbidden.

The Camp Director and Sponsors are responsible for the enforcement of all policies and rules and the supervision of their groups at all times.

Sponsors are responsible for the campers' care of equipment and buildings. Sponsors are also responsible to see that campers are not left unsupervised in the cabins at any time.

Each Camp is responsible for any and all damages to the Camp property. The camp group is expected to leave the camp grounds and buildings clean before leaving.

Signs, posters, decorations, etc. must not be affixed to any painted surface or interior walls without prior approval of camp manager.

Camp #4 Night Services: Clothing considered appropriate for the Sunday Evening services at your church are to be worn during the evening services at camp.
