The above-named group agrees to the following terms and conditions:

1. Abide by all camp rules and regulations.
2. Keep all buildings and facilities clean and orderly.
3. Pick up trash on campgrounds and dispose of properly at the end of your event.
4. Pine Springs Baptist Camp will not be responsible for items left behind before, during or after an event.
5. In cases where property has been damaged or abused beyond normal wear, above named group will be billed for all damages and additional clean-up.

Fees: (unless otherwise agreed upon)

Retreats (1-2 Nights)	\$21 per night per person first night, \$16 additional nights \$5 per meal A deposit of \$250 is due at the time the above-named group enters into this agreement. The deposit becomes non-refundable 30 days prior to the event if a cancellation notice has not been received.
Camps (3 -4 Nights)	\$90 – Groups belonging to the American Baptist Association \$125 – All other groups Evening meal on day of arrival through breakfast meal on day of departure is included. Price for any additional meals is \$5 per person. A deposit of \$500 is due at the time the above-named group enters into this agreement. The deposit becomes non-refundable 45 days prior to the event if a cancellation notice has not been received. A deposit is not necessary for established camps.
Day Use	\$5 per person
Building use	\$250 for day use of the tabernacle. \$250 for day use of cafeteria.

Pool Rental	For groups up to 35: \$125 for 2 hours, \$50 for each additional hour For groups over 35: \$150 for 2 hours, \$65 for each additional hour
Lake Rental	\$225 for two hours, \$100 each additional hour

Retreats and Camps have full use of the camps facilities unless otherwise specified by the camp manager. For any special request, contact the camp manager.

Camp Rules

- This is a Christian Camp. The conduct of each camper should be in keeping with Christian camping.
- No personal pets are permitted during camps or retreats.
- No smoking is permitted on camp property.
- Alcoholic beverages, firearms, or gambling are not permitted.
- Modest dress should be always practiced.
- Swimming will be permitted only during scheduled periods when lifeguards are on duty.
- Each camper is expected to attend religious services and participate in the recreational and educational programs.
- Any building defacing activities are forbidden.
- The Camp Director/Leader and Sponsors are responsible for the enforcement of all policies and rules and the supervision of their groups at all times.
- Sponsors are responsible for the campers' care of equipment and buildings. Sponsors are also responsible to see that campers are not left unsupervised in the cabins at any time.
- Each Camp is responsible for any and all damages to the Camp property. The camp group is expected to leave the campgrounds and buildings clean before leaving.
- Signs, posters, decorations, etc. must not be affixed to any painted surface or interior walls without prior approval of camp manager.

VIOLATION OF CAMP POLICIES AND RULES MAY RESULT IN EXPULSION FROM THE CAMP WITH NO REFUND OF ANY FEES PAID

Other Requirements

- Each group is responsible to provide their own medical personnel that is qualified to administer medication and provide first aid.
- Any camper or sponsor attending that is the age of 18 or older, must pass a criminal conviction and sexual misconduct background check. Records of criminal convictions should be obtained by performing a criminal background check using a criminal history database for each adult volunteer's permanent residence. Records of sex offender status should be obtained by performing a check using a sex offender registration database for each adult volunteer's permanent residence, such as the TXDPS – Sex Offender Registry, which may be accessed at the Texas Department of Public Safety – Crime Records Service.
- Also, each camper 18 and older must complete a Child Protection Training course. An approved course fulfilling these requirements can be found on the camp website. The certificate of completion for this course should also be attached to the registration forms of those campers over 18.

- Any **visitor** that could potentially have unsupervised contact with a child not their own must also fulfill the requirements of having a criminal conviction and sexual misconduct background check and complete the Child Protection Training.

Indemnification

The above named group agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless Pine Springs Baptist Camp and its employees from and against any and all claims, demands, causes of action, or liabilities incurred by Pine Springs Baptist Camp or its employees, arising from above named group's acts or omissions of above named group's vendors, employees, contractors, or persons attending the meeting or event with the express or implied permission or invitation of above named group, except as may arise from the negligence or willful misconduct of Pine Springs Baptist Camp or its employees.

Pine Springs Baptist Camp will not be held responsible for any losses, damages, or injuries. This refers to any loss, damage, or injury to persons or possessions that may occur at any function held on this property, from any cause, whatsoever, prior to, during, or subsequent to the period covered by this agreement. The above-named group will be responsible for the control and supervision of the people in attendance during the use of the facility to ensure no harm is done to persons or property.

The above-named group agrees to abide by this Agreement and acknowledges having received a copy thereof. The above-named group will be held financially responsible for any damage to the Facility or equipment, which occurs through the above-named group's meeting or event at the facility.

Pine Springs Baptist Camp is owned and operated by the American Baptist Association. PSBC primarily exists to aid the churches of the American Baptist Association in carrying out the great commission by providing a venue for the teaching of the good news of Jesus Christ. Secondly, Pine Springs Baptist Camp exists to aid others who share the same vision and goal of spreading the good news of Jesus Christ. While not all groups desiring to use PSBC are religious in nature, it is expected that any group attending PSBC hold to Christian values and seek to instill Christian values in the campers attending.
